Terms:

Corps to corps- bodies coming together after a head cut

Moulinet- a circular cut

Bind- forcing the opponent's blade into the diagonally opposite line

Croisé- forcing a fighter's blade to the high or low line on the same side of the body, by gliding along the forte of the blade

Evades:

Duck

Jump

Middle cut

Traverse

Injuries:

Cuts- after a bind for example

Pommel- blunt strike with the bottom of the handle of the blade
